

PEAK PERIOD RESTRICTIONS (2011-2012)

OWNER'S OCCUPANCY OF THE UNIT:

- 28 days per calendar year per unit
- Maximum of 14 nights between December 26th and April 30th of each calendar year

PEAK PERIOD RESTRICTIONS

- Easter (week before actual date)
- Spring Break Periods (floating periods before and after Easter)
- Holidays and certain days before and after Holidays such as New Year, Memorial Day and 4th of July
- Summer Weekends: approximately mid-June to mid-August from Friday afternoon to Sunday morning
- Special Events such as: Super Bowl, political conventions, World Series, etc., including local and area major events
